All tags require closing tags unless otherwise noted.

### General Document Formatting

Tag	Meaning	Attributes
 	Line break	No closing tag needed
<div>	Document section/division	
<h1> through <h6>	Heading/section (h1) through sub-sub-subsection (h6)	h1 is the largest, h6 is the smallest
<p>	Paragraph	
<span>	Group of inline elements	

### Text Formatting

Tag	Meaning	Attributes
<b>	<b>Bold</b> text	
<blockquote>	Block quotation	
<cite>	Citation, like for a book title	
<code>	Computer code style	
<em>	Emphasized text	
<hr>	Horizontal rule (line)	No closing tag needed
<i>	<i>Italicized</i> text	
<pre>	Pre-formatted text	
<q>	Quotation	
<s>	<del>Strikethrough</del> text	
<small>	Smaller text	
<strong>	Important/strong emphasized text	
<sub>	Subscript	
<sup>	Superscript	
<u>	<u>Underlined</u> text	

## Lists

Tag	Meaning	Attributes
<dl>	Definition list (like a glossary)	
<dt>	Definition term (keyword)	
<dd>	Definition data (item text)	
<ol>	Ordered (numbered) list	
<ul>	Unordered (bulleted) list	
<li>	List item	Used for ordered and unordered lists

## Tables

Tag	Meaning	Attributes
<table>	Table opening/closing tag	
<tr>	Table row opening/closing tag	
<th>	Table header cell	
<td>	Table data cell	

## Miscellaneous

Tag	Meaning	Attributes
<a>	Anchor (used for hyperlinks)	<i>href = URL to link to</i>
<img>	Image	<i>src = Path/URL to image file</i> <i>alt = Alternate text to display</i> width and height: used to scale image No closing tag needed
